

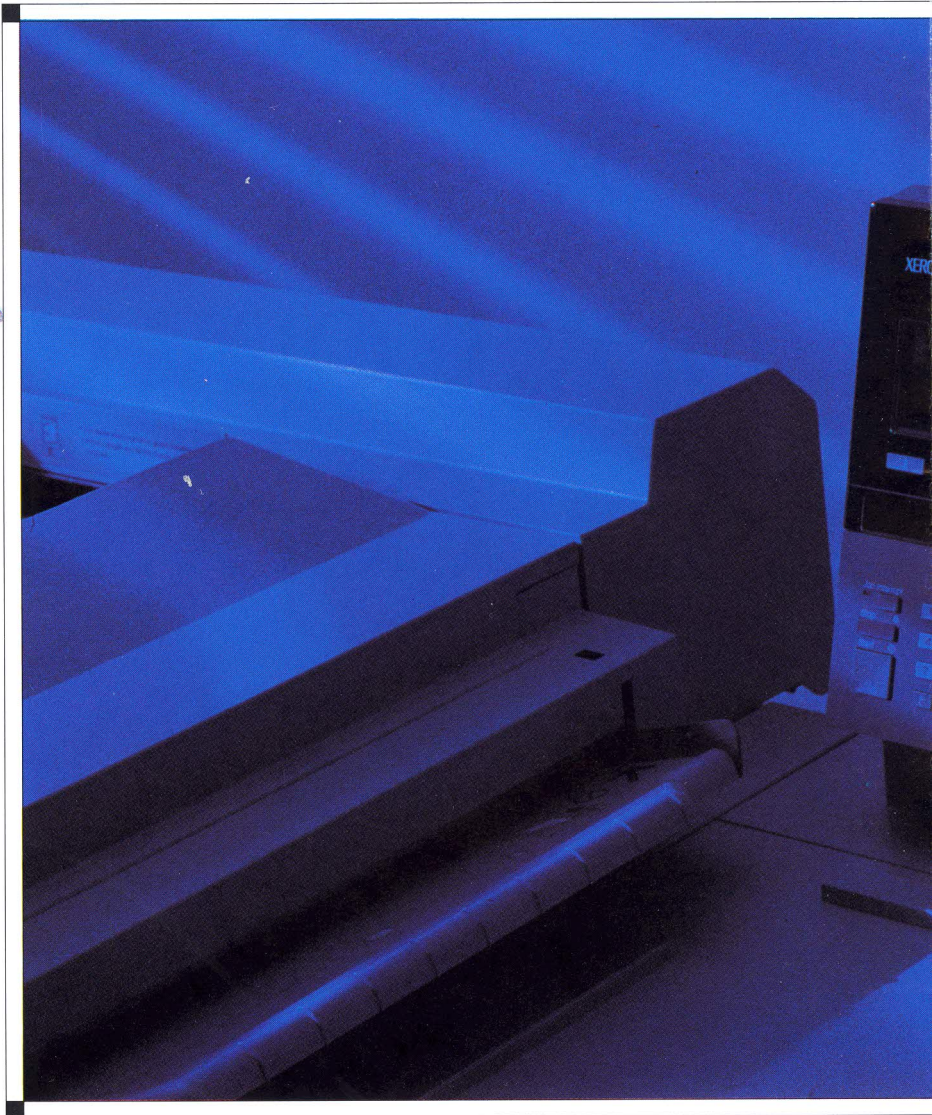

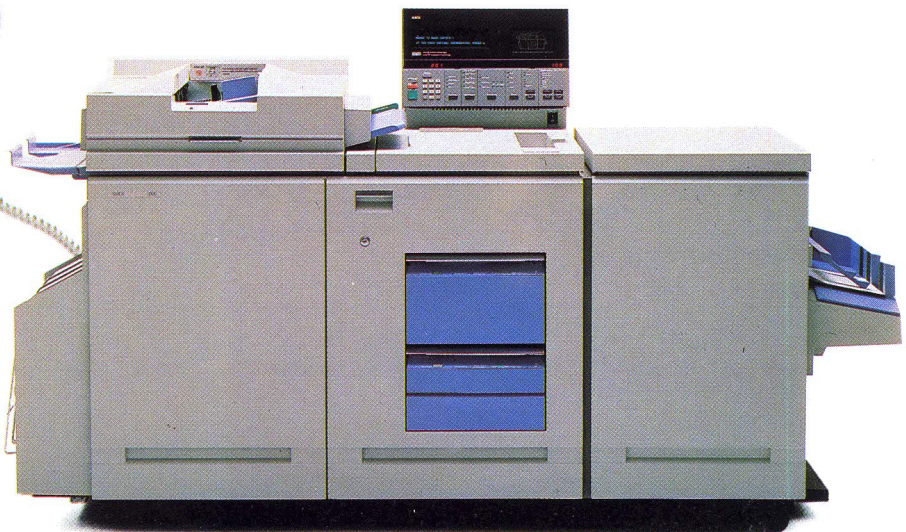

One of the key features of the 1090 which makes it attractive to both a casual and a dedicated operator is the Universal Document Handler which can function in three modes, including a Continuous Forms Feeder (CFF). Other features include pre-programming of up to nine repetitive copying jobs, continuous paper tray switching, and automatic covers and variable sheet insertion. A reclamation system cleans and returns excess dry-ink to minimize waste.

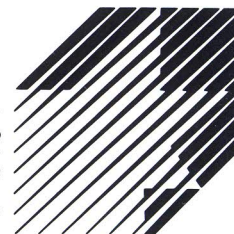
